### What is CSF?

Founded in 1921, the California Scholarship Federation is the oldest scholarship institution in the state of California. Its purpose is to foster high standards of scholarship and service in California high schools. Membership in CSF is open to students who have met designated qualifications.

Life Members (Gold Seal Bearers) wear a gold honor stole at commencement and are identified in the commencement program. A gold seal is attached to the student's diploma and notation of this honor is made on the student's permanent transcript.
